

Why *Nature Never Stops Talking* is So Vital to the Church

The belief that evolution is scientific fact has a far greater impact on the church and civilization than we may have ever realized.

In this article, I want to point out possibly things you have not considered before and why the book *Nature Never Stops Talking* can go a long way in solving many of these problems and what you can do.

Whether an electron around an atom is red or orange will change our lives very little. Whether the erosion on Mars is caused by wind or radioactive storms will also impact us very little. The first chapter of Romans verse 20 says

“For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.” NASB

Of course, evolution denies that His attributes are clearly seen. In reality, everything we study in science compels us to marvel at the complexity and amazing functionality on so many levels of nature everywhere.

Unlike so many practical branches of science, evolution is in a completely different category because it declares the meaning of your life or lack of it. Evolution declares that the book of Genesis is untrue and that nature does not reveal any intelligence. Evolution demands you do not say “well done” but insists you say “how lucky”. Evolution is at war with ideologies. But none of these reasons is a valid enough reason for any honest person to reject truth. If evolution has been scientifically proven then we must accept the truth because truth never contradicts truth.

But still, evolution goes beyond the truth. It goes around the truth and it manipulates the truth and in fact, it is and never has been scientifically proven. Therefore, I must urge all seekers of the truth to consider what I am presenting.

Currently, one of the basic tenets of the scientific community is any reference to a superior intelligence other than man is a decisive exit from science. Without the statement, the meaning of this tenet is simply man is the ultimate intelligence in the universe and any other opinion is scientifically invalid and will be treated as such.

Dear reader, we have a very big and very complex problem that is solvable and must be solved. This is no little tangent from what is important. The Israelites came upon the threshold of the Promised Land and backed away believing they could not defeat the “giants”. We are in our promised land but the idea of evolution has been so overwhelmingly successful in achieving scientifically valid status that even the Catholic Church has officially told its members to accept it. Every official science textbook in every public school in America incorporates it as fact. Every science TV program, every science magazine, every field of science assumes evolution as absolute fact. Its tentacles have reached far beyond the realm of science and into the psyche of our communities. Psychologists and psychiatrists refer to our instincts leftover from our animal origins. God Himself has been largely discredited in a nation based on Christian precepts. The Bible has been undermined by the idea that science has crushed its reliability with proof beyond controversy. The meaning of life has been reduced to mere survival. Absolute morality cannot be real if all that exists is a result of unguided, impersonal and random

events. Spiritual quests are mere medication to escape the insignificance of life rather than quests genuinely answering life questions. Evolution says, “What spirituality?” Oh yeah, a giant, but one that can be beat.

Am I exaggerating? If evolution is true, how can there be a heaven and hell? If evolution is true, to whom are any of us accountable?

If everyone leaves the debate table and we leave only nature to testify on its own behalf we discover that nature’s design is enviably beyond the intelligence of all human science. To discredit all references to a superior intelligence is to silence the testimony of all of nature. How scientific is that?

Rational thinking is always attracted to what is provable. Rational thinking always looks for consistency to confirm conclusions or theories.

If a church member has already concluded evolution is true and Genesis is symbolic or simply untrue, we cannot convince him otherwise with scripture. We must convince him with science.

If a church member remains steadfast to believing Genesis but has no answer to those open to his reason for disbelieving evolution, let us provide him answers. Of little value are answers that he can memorize but mean little to him. Answers that are quotes from scientists that have different minds are also weak reasons for the man. We must equip a person with answers that come from the man himself. Let us provide reasons that the common man relates to so well, that the reasons become his own.

Let us also provide answers to the man who declares he cannot yield to Christianity because it has been disproved by evolution.

Let us provide answers that the young can understand and follow.

And for all, rather than provide rote answers. Let us give them the way of thinking and perceiving so they can answer from their own reasoning instead of quoting others.

There are many things that transcend languages, nationalism, ethnic groups, religious and philosophies. Music is one. Love is another. Family is another. Nature is another.

The theory of evolution seems to have transcended many boundaries to gain acceptance in most circles. Possibly the majority of churchgoers agree that the major tenets of evolution are true. Civilizations have been duped.

To argue universal acceptance of evolution, why handicap ourselves by launching our argument from our particular religion or culture? Nature is universal and it neither lies nor has an agenda and no one is suspicious of nature. Let nature testify to the truth. In fact, the Bible reveals that nature does have an agenda that no evolutionist would admit. Nature will cry out God’s glory.

In the book, *Nature Never Stops Talking* that is what is presented. The more anyone looks at nature, the more impressed we become with its ingenuity, its efficiency, its variety, its sophistication, its complexity, its size, its glory. By simply presenting some aspect of nature, the evidence mounts against the notion that it is a result of mindless accidents.

The more we avoid the war with words and ideologies, the plainer nature speaks.

Nature Never Stops Talking intentionally avoids high-brow science or quoting experts. Nature speaks plainly, so does the author. The author does not give a 1,000 page

lecture on complicated theories exasperating the reader into submission. Like nature, there are many moments articulating beauty and wisdom. 1-3 page articles, bite-size, easy to contemplate thoughts. The sequence is unimportant just like showing a child the marvels of nature requires no particular sequence. It is all marvelous in any order.

We do not require a PhD to understand that a sunset is beautiful or that the spring flowers on the foothills is inspiring. Without training we still understand that it is amazing how animals give birth with instinctive knowledge. The incomprehensible miracle of sight requires no explanation to impress us with engineering power far beyond our own. Likewise, *Nature Never Stops Talking* is not winsome by piling up expert quotes or references to things we do not understand. Instead, *Nature Never Stops Talking* brushes aside arguments to play cupid between the reader and nature; encouraging the reader to simply believe what they can plainly see for themselves.

The author refrains from using the limitless wonder of nature as a mere stepping stone to an ideology or religious statement. Unadulterated. Untainted. Nature speaks for itself. Nature is best heard uninterrupted, un-interpreted, and unexplained. The more we listen to nature with the honesty of a child, the plainer we hear it speaking.

Nature IS the hard evidence of intelligence greater than man. Just listen and you soon find that *Nature Never Stops Talking*.

The church must procure information in the universal language of nature. Even the Bible testifies that nature testifies to the truth.

The problems do loom large. The importance is simply as important as standing against principalities and powers that rob God of credibility in His Word and the overwhelming choir of testimony of nature turned to a testimony of the meaninglessness of life.
